EMERGENCY ORDER NUMBER 2021-111

SMALL PURCHASE PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, Louisiana Procurement Code, R.S. 39:1506, as amended, establishes procedures and amounts for the procurement of small purchases, and procurement requirements shall not be construed to be in violation of the Code under this Section.”

NOW THEREFORE, I, Jeff Landry, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution of the State of Louisiana, do hereby direct as follows:

Section 1. All departments, offices, agencies, boards, commissions, and other agencies of the executive branch of state government, and the officers and employees thereof, (hereafter "agency") shall observe, be guided by, and implement the specific directives on small purchase procedures set forth in this Order in the following manner: the purchasing authority delegated to an agency by its chief procurement officer in R.S. 39:1506.156 provision of this Order shall be construed as a limitation on the number of quotations to be solicited prior to making a purchase or procurement. Local and state-owned businesses especially, minority-owned businesses and certified veteran-owned businesses and entrepreneurships should be utilized.

Section 2: Unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the words and terms used in this Order shall have the following meanings:

- A. "Small purchases" means (1) any procurement of supplies, materials or services exceeding \$25,000, or (2) any procurement of services exceeding \$25,000 under this Order, which shall be exempt from the competitive bidding requirements of the Louisiana Procurement Code, as provided in that Section.

Section 7: All departments, offices, or any political subdivision thereof, are authorized and directed to cooperate in the implementation of this Order.


Section 8: Executive Order number IRE 2020-21 is hereby rescinded.
